

1 Leslie Fain did not tell her about this story about
2 finding the body and not calling for help for an hour
3 and a half. The evidence will show she did not speak to
4 Leslie Fain. Neither did Geraldine Bellanger, the
5 Defendant's mother.

6 During the course of the April 15 interview
7 Defendant also told Investigator Sieling and Agent
8 Baumann that on the morning of the murder he called Doug
9 Haverkamp to see if he could give him a ride to Mahnomen
10 and then go to Fargo for his loan. The Defendant told
11 the officers that Haverkamp had said to him that he
12 needed to go to Ulen, so it wouldn't be a problem for
13 Haverkamp to drive the Defendant to Mahnomen and then
14 Fargo. Law enforcement officers also questioned Doug
15 Haverkamp about the events concerning the morning of the
16 murder. The evidence will show that Haverkamp had never
17 intended on going to Ulen that day and that he never
18 told the Defendant that he was going to Ulen that day.
19 The evidence will show that he and his roommate had
20 plans to go to Detroit Lakes that day to get something
21 to eat.

22 Now, that morning when he called -- called to
23 speak to Doug Haverkamp the evidence will show he does
24 not have a cell phone but he has a roommate, Brad
25 Riggle, and the Defendant called Brad Riggle's cell

1 phone at 9:20 and asked to speak to Haverkamp and then
2 asked Haverkamp to give him a ride to Mahnomen and
3 Fargo. Haverkamp agrees and they tell the Defendant
4 they will come over. Now, while driving to the
5 Defendant's place, Riggle gets another phone call from
6 the Defendant, and this was at approximately 9:34 and
7 the Defendant tells them don't go to my house. Meet me
8 at my sister's, Liz Andersen's. They drive -- they
9 drive there and they find him parked at the end of the
10 driveway in his truck. Brad Riggle asks if he can come
11 along with them to go up to Fargo and Andersen tells him
12 they are going to be up there all day, and there was
13 some more conversation back and forth, but finally
14 Riggle said, or testified, that he got the impression
15 that the Defendant didn't want him to go with.
16 Haverkamp then drives the Defendant to Mahnomen to get
17 his taxes and then towards Fargo.

18 Eventually they actually go to Moorhead, as
19 the evidence will show. Defendant goes to Citifinancial
20 in Moorhead. Haverkamp waits in the truck. A short
21 while later the Defendant comes out and says to
22 Haverkamp Ken Swedberg has been shot. We have to go.
23 Haverkamp, the evidence will show, said that as they are
24 driving down the road the Defendant gets another phone
25 call and Defendant tells him that it was Chad Swedberg

1 that had been shot and not Ken Swedberg. They returned
2 to Andersen's house shortly after 1 o'clock.

3 Now, law enforcement officers confirmed the
4 Defendant met with Nichole Knudson, branch manager of
5 Citifinancial in Moorhead, regarding his loan on that
6 day. They also learned Defendant had made application
7 for a loan with Citifinancial April 9 over the phone.
8 Nichole Knudson will testify that the Defendant told her
9 the loan was for a home improvement project because
10 Knudson's branch doesn't have and doesn't offer business
11 loans. Knudson set up appointment on April 12th to meet
12 with her about that loan but he failed to show. Nichole
13 Knudson says that on April 13th the Defendant showed up
14 without an appointment. She says that she couldn't
15 process the loan for him that day because Andersen
16 didn't have the necessary tax returns with him.

17 Nichole Knudson described the Defendant's
18 demeanor that day as being nervous and agitated.
19 Defendant had made several phone calls while at
20 Citifinancial to -- to obtain or to see if he could get
21 some tax information faxed to the bank. He tells her
22 that he can't get the information; that he thinks the
23 tax preparer's place is closed. He also says --
24 Nichole Knudson also states that the Defendant received
25 a cell phone call while he was there. After hanging up

1 from that cell phone he says to her my business partner
2 has just been shot. I need to go. The Defendant leaves
3 Citifinancial. The evidence will show that the
4 Defendant and Ken Swedberg had never been involved in a
5 business relationship.

6 Now, the Defendant was interviewed on two
7 different dates regarding the information about how he
8 heard Chad Swedberg was shot. He was interviewed on
9 April 15th and he was interviewed on June 7. During the
10 interview of April 15th the Defendant tells
11 Investigators Sieling and Baumann that it was his niece
12 that had called him while he was at Citifinancial and
13 that she told him that Ken Swedberg had been shot. He
14 also tells the officers that day that she calls him back
15 and tells him that he was dead.

16 Now, the investigators again question the
17 Defendant on June 7th and ask him about the phone calls.
18 During this interview the Defendant tells the officers
19 his niece told him that it was Ken Swedberg that had
20 been shot. He says she called him once or twice, three
21 times, and then called him after that --. Excuse me.
22 She says that she called him initially and said it was
23 Ken Swedberg that had been shot and then she called back
24 a couple times more and said it was Chad Swedberg that
25 had been shot.
