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CONVERSATION WITH LIZ MARIE ANDERSEN

Questioning by #602/Capt Joe McArthur of the Becker County Sheriff's Office.

(background noise unable to hear)

Q. I'm going to talk with her a little bit here, so...

Q. (625/Deputy Dan Skoog) You guys – you guys need anything, ah, if you need something, just call.

Q. Yeah, I'll do that.

Q. (625) Okay.

(long break without speaking)

A. My shoes a little muddy, Joe, but -

Q. Ah, don't worry.

A. I just wore my old shoes.

Q. I know that they don't – I – I haven't talked to you about this yet, you know. I know –

A. No. The only one I talked to was, uhm, John, and there was a – I don't know who the other guy was that came out.

Q. That was – that was awhile back though, wasn't it?

A. This was just, ah, maybe a couple weeks ago, 'cuz they had to come and go through what guns were here, that I had of Kenny's here.

Q. Okay, and then, oh, let me get – let me just get your full name and date of birth. Start up the air conditioner, make it a little more comfortable.

A. There you go, 'cuz it's warm.

Q. I know we probably have this, but...and what's your middle name again?

A. Marie and it's Andersen now, S-E-N. My date of birth is 4-7-67.

Q. And Kenny, y – when – do you remember when he brought the guns over here that he brought?

A. Uhm, that was in the wintertime. Oh, God, it – it was really icky. It was real – we had lots of snow yet.

Q. Okay.

A. It was during the winter.

43 on that skid steer as far as I know.

14 except for that day, you know. So I went over. It was Leslie and that little girl and
15 she had the dogs up there and I said "Hey, Leslie." You know, how things are going,
16 you know. Must have been a good 45 minutes I talked with her and I - and I just
17 asked her, I said "Les, can I ask you something?" She goes "Yeah, Liz, what's that?"
18 and I go "Have you ever heard of, you know, anything with Chad yet?" I said "You
19 know, it's kind of weird, you know." And out of the blue she just goes "You know
20 what, Liz? It was Chad's day to die. So the good Lord wanted him." And I thought,
21 well, you know, maybe it's just 'cuz she's mourning and, you know, it's Chad's
22 birthday and different things like that and then she made a remark about Tommy,
23 whatever his last name is, and then she goes "Well he's leaving the 29th, Liz, so he
24 won't be in trouble." Well me and Tasha kind of looked at each other, you know,
25 thinking, okay, it's time to go, and I told John that. I said I don't know if it was just,
26 you know, her way of mourning, but I said that was a weird remark to say.

27

28 Q. Yeah. Yeah.

29 A. And that was May 8th. I remember that 'cuz it was Chad's birthday and she was
30 sitting on, you know, up on the - up at Chad's grave that evening. I think it was
31 around 6:30. Between 6:30 and 7, but that was the only time I've ever talked to
32 her...but there's just so many different rumors going around.

35 A. First all we heard was Kenny. Then we heard it was little Art. Then we heard it was
36 Al Baker, you know.

I am writing this letter on behalf of Kenneth Eugene Olson. I was recently asked if I ever remember a van that Chadberg may have owned. I do in fact remember this van and will mention in this letter my recollection of said van.

I remember that around the end of November of 2006 Chadberg was in fact in possession of a yellowish colored panel van. I am sure with a certain level of certainty that this time line is correct because I at the time owned a 1980's F150 that had 2 wheel drive. I had this vehicle then and know that it is so because I got it from a high school buddy when he was on his way to basic training for the navy, and he didn't join until a year after we graduated in 2005.

The significance of this vehicle I owned is that it was a wheel drive. I was unable to drive it onto the lake in which I was trying to set up a spear fish house around that time. So as I tried to push this 4ft x 8ft fish house on the lake by hand, Chad Swedberg with who I believe to be Jesse Fair drove by and saw me on the lake. Norcross Lake aka. Nob's is easily visible from 74th St near White Earth in Becker County.

As Chad drove by he saw me and turned in a driveway that heads toward the lake. He came out onto the lake on foot and helped me push the house to the area I wanted to fish. When we got it there I had to go back to my truck and get a saw to cut my holes open and he stayed because he wanted to know how thick the ice was. When I was getting the saw and spear, etc... from truck is when I saw Jesse sitting in the van waiting for Chad. After my holes were cut and Chad helped me push house over my holes and back up the house he wished me good luck and left. Point being that I know that Chad that day was driving the van in question. And I know that Jesse was there with him that day.

I had a prior interaction with Chad as he drove that van just a week or 2 earlier as ~~the~~ hunting party I was with were setting up to do a deer drive near Spirit Lake. Spirit Lake is only about a mile west of Norcross Lake on the same road.

We were waiting for the standers to get into ~~position~~ ^{position} before we walked through the woods and pushed deer toward them. There were a few of us waiting on 374th St. when Chad drove up and stopped and talked to us briefly. At this time Chad was also driving the van in question.

In summary, I am an eye witness to the fact that Chad owned or at the least had access and/or possession of this van for approximately 1 month during November/December of 2006. I am willing to testify to this in any court of law. Whether this is helpful to Kenny's case or not I will testify to what I know is true.

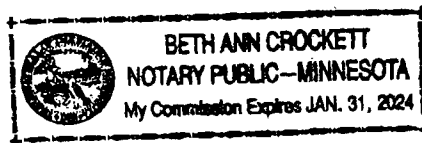
